Cancer Services of New Mexico's Fall 2019 Family Cancer Retreat

Overview

The Fall 2019 Family Cancer Retreat provides New Mexico's adult cancer patients/survivors, their family members, and loved ones who serve as their primary caregivers with a weekend of education, reflection, and rejuvenation in a relaxing and nurturing environment.

The retreat *focuses on educating participants on the process of surviving cancer*. Topics covered range from the difficulties of handling the initial diagnosis, coping with therapy and recovery, and a variety of medical and social topics relating to at-home care and the emotional issues associated with surviving.



The Program

During the weekend, we will intersperse lectures and discussions on a variety of cancer-related topics with fun activities that provide a break from the day-to-day challenges of living with cancer.

The retreat also provides participants with the opportunity to meet and spend time talking with others who are coping with similar issues. During these informal moments, ideas and tips are shared, and new friendships are made.

Supervised child care and recreational activities will be provided for children and teens during the educational sessions.

The program will be held from September 13-15, 2019 at the Marriott Pyramid North hotel in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

There is no charge to participate in the retreat — the entire program, including meals, lodging, and all educational activities is provided at no cost to participants. If these arrangements will not meet your family's requirements, please contact us **before** returning your application to discuss how we might accommodate you.

Once we receive your application form, we will review it closely and get back to you within a few weeks to let you know if we will be able to accommodate your family. If so, we will send you a registration packet containing a variety of materials, including a detailed agenda, participant information forms, physician consent form, medical/liability waiver form, and a map.
